

2018 Call for Travel Grant Applications

The European Doctoral Programme “Unity and Difference in the European Legal Area“ (EPEDER) at Humboldt-Universität zu Berlin is currently accepting applications for Travel Grants intended to enable one-month research stays.

1. The EPEDER programme

The doctoral programme EPEDER investigates the conditions, boundaries and implications of interdependencies between national legal systems resulting from the progressing Europeanisation and internationalisation of law. The programme is closely embedded in the European Law School Network (ELS), which consists of Humboldt-Universität zu Berlin, King's College London, Universiteit van Amsterdam, Université Paris 2 Panthéon-Assas, La Sapienza-Università di Roma, and as an associated partner, the European University Institute (EUI) in Florence.

2. The Travel Grant

The Travel Grant will be provided by the Law Faculty of the Humboldt-Universität zu Berlin and is granted thanks to Excellence Initiative funding. It aims at enabling targeted research stays for PhD Law students and postdoctoral researchers in Law. Successful applicants will receive a one-off payment of EUR 1,000 covering travel expenditures and living costs for the duration of their research stay.

3. Possible time span for the research stay in Berlin

Travel grant holders should finish their research stay no later than 15 December 2018. They are highly encouraged to overlap their research stay with the second *International Conference for Young Scholars* of the EPEDER, held in Berlin from 14 to 16 November 2018. Candidates who also decide to apply for the conference will be prioritized in the selection process.

4. The application procedure

Your application file should include

- Cover letter (*max. 1 page*)
- Complete CV, including a publication list if applicable (*max. 2 pages*)
- Summary of the research project to be pursued during the stay in Berlin (*max. 5 pages*)

All application materials should be submitted as one PDF file.

The application deadline is **16 September 2018**.
